

20th International Society for Pediatric and Adolescent Diabetes Science School for Healthcare Professionals Report

Date: September 15-17, 2024

Location: Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA

The ISPAD Science School for Physicians 2024 was held at the University Club (University of Pittsburgh), in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA from September 22nd to September 27th, 2024.

It offered an incredible opportunity to enhance knowledge, share experiences and develop friendships. Attended by 19 delegates representing 14 countries (Brazil, Canada, Guatemala, Mexico, USA, Italy, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, United Kingdom, Egypt, India, Nepal) and 20 faculty members, including the JENIOUS leadership, it covered principles of research methodology and state of the art lectures on all aspects of diabetes research, including aetiology, pathogenesis, prediction, prevention, management and natural history of diabetes in children, adolescents and young adults.
